

UBCF works with breast cancer and health related charities doing great work in their communities. We also work with other outreach nonprofits to raise breast cancer awareness and support those in need.






### Why Join?

We work with many nonprofits across country who don't have staff or capacity to acquire large donations.


UBCF can accommodate our Charity Members needs to provide a manageable amount of goods for maximum impact.

Reports must be submitted to UBCF until 100% of the received products are distributed.




